#### **Graduation Ceremony**

#### **English Week**

In order to boost students' interest and provide them with more exposure to the use of English inside and outside classroom, English Week was held by English Department and English Society from 20<sup>th</sup> June to 24<sup>th</sup> June 2022. The theme of English Week this year is 'Love and Care', which serves to remind students of the importance of showing affection for their loved ones amidst the pandemic. During the week, students took part in various entertaining activities in which they could apply the language they had learnt.



Penmanship Competition was the first activity of the week with the aims to encourage students to appreciate the importance of family love through the reading of poems as well as to unleash their artistic potentials. Two poems about the importance of family love were given to junior form and senior form students respectively and we were glad to see that all students from F.1 to F.6 participated enthusiastically, putting in their best effort to showcase their talent. The winning students demonstrated exceptional artistic abilities in line and character spacing, letter construction, and letterform proportions.

To help students build their vocabulary, strengthen spelling, and practice concentration, the fun **Word Search Competition** introduced all students from F.1 to F.6 to different types of pets, including the common and the rare ones. Two sets of worksheets were given to junior and senior form students respectively and it came as a surprise that junior formers excelled in the competition, often completing the worksheet ahead of time. This made us wonder if our younger ones could have beaten the older boys if they had been placed in the same competition. Well done, junior formers!

In collaboration with the Religious Studies Committee, English Crossover RS Crossword Competition was organised to improve students' vocabulary as well as to allow students to learn more about one of the Christian traditions, the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul. Students were invited to watch a video prepared by the Religious Studies Committee before completing a crossword puzzle related to the video on a Google Form. Students completed the crossword puzzle instantly when the QR code was shown in class and were impatient for the results to be released.

The most exciting activity of the week was **Singing Contest**. Different from the previous singing contests, students were invited to videotape their singing (and dancing if they wish) of their favourite English songs. It was such a precious and rare opportunity in these recent years for students to take part in a singing contest, which has always been a popular event at school. Students welcomed it enthusiastically but only a few brave ones turned in their pieces. However, the few pieces of singing were of excellent quality; our judges were amazed by our students' incredible singing talents!

Soon after the week, the winning students of various activities received their awards during a morning assembly broadcast live on Campus TV. We would like to congratulate all the winning students and thank everyone for supporting English Week!
